

GERALD L. SALING MEMORIAL ROTARY SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

The Rotary Club of Spokane North will award two (2) \$1,500 scholarships to students who will be (or are) enrolled in an accredited college or university. This may be used for tuition, board, room or any other required school fee. The applicants shall be evaluated based on the established guidelines, without discrimination because of race, creed, gender or national origin.

ELIGIBILITY: An applicant must:

1. Be a high school graduate by the end of this school year. Two scholarships will be awarded, one to a relative (spouse, son, daughter, grandchild, niece or nephew) of a Spokane North Rotary Club member or if, there are no qualified applicants, to any qualified relative of another Rotary Club. The second scholarship will be awarded to the most deserving candidate regardless of Rotary relationship.
2. Have an overall 3.00 GPA.
3. Have applied to or are enrolled in an accredited postsecondary educational program.
4. Students may reapply each year.

3. Enclose a copy of high school or college transcript.

Applications must be received by **MAY 18th, 2010**. Final selection of recipients will be made by the Scholarship Committee of the Rotary Club of Spokane North. The award is to be used toward the student's school expenses and will be awarded on June 7th, 2010.
